

3 December 1981

The first meeting of the "Rollin Squares" was held at the home of Bill & Inge Leisten on 3 December 1981.

The meeting was called to order at 8:12 p.m. by president Bill Leisten. Members present were: Leonard & Marylin Shaffer, Steve and Petra Jones, Bill and Inge Leisten, and Lee & Lee Pravitz.

The constitution and by-laws were discussed. A motion was made to accept them as they are, by Marylin Shaffer. Lee Pravitz seconded, and the motion was passed.

As this was the first meeting of the "Rollin Squares", there was no old business.

Under new business: A trip to Holland on the 12th of December was discussed. We will leave from the Shaffer home on Friday night, (the 11th) at 5 p.m. If the weather permits, all will be going. Lee Pravitz will call Big Ben to make arrangements for rooms for all. We will be taking two vans, the Jones' and the Shaffers'. All gas expenses will be divided 4 ways to help cut the cost. We shall be returning on Sunday, the 13th of December, 1981. Dutch guilders are needed for the trip. The cost of the rooms should be about 35 guilders per person. Our first club dance will be in a windmill. Steve Jones and Bill Leisten will bring the tapes to dance to. The route of travel to Holland was then discussed.

Announcement of the January 30th Fasching Dance hosted by the Karlsruhe Kut-Ups was made.

President Bill Leisten asked that all check their calendars to see if there might be somewhere special that they would like to go for a dance or to see.

In July, the group will be going to the British Isles for 2 weeks. More discussion as July comes closer.

Everyone was asked to think about a 5 country 24 hour or 10 country 48 hour tour sponsored by the Rollin Squares.

The discussion about club outfits resulted in Inge Leisten suggesting that each lady bring in three styles so that a selection can be made. Colors will be blue and white. Two outfits will be needed (1 good outfit and 1 extra. A peasant blouse and skirt for the ladies will be the travelling outfit.

Three important factors were brought up: (Badges for Van's (men); Trailers (ladies) and Tag-a-longs (children). Lee Pravitz will talk with some of his people at work on making up a design. He thinks that there is a place that will make a silk-screen pattern for about \$50.00. The badges will be _____ writing on _____ background. On the badge will be the unit number for the whole family.

Dues were discussed. They were set at \$25.00 per year per family unit, payable upon the first of the year and/or membership.

Officers of the club were selected: They are as follows: President- Bill Leisten. Wagon Master - Leonard Shaffer; Secretary - (She) Lee Pravitz; Historian - Petra Jones. Lee Pravitz agreed to assist Petra with photo support for historical records.

The discussion then turned to membership. One prime concern was that couples be married (as performed by legal authority). This is due to our concern as parents for the benefit of children. Couples must be married as indicated above.

Guests: If you bring a guest on a trip/event, they are your responsibility as sponsor, to include costs, and accommodations, including dancing.


Two inquires of membership have been received. Information packets will be mailed to them.
