

Rollin Squares Meeting - 18 Sept 83

1425 hours

Meeting held at the Leisten home. Present were 1, 2, 3, 5.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The Treasurers Report showed \$150.00 and 16.25 DM. All members were reminded that 83 dues are past due and several made amends.

President noted that ballots were received from only two families. Approved that officers stay in position until elections next year.

Discussion of club outfits was postponed until the next meeting. Kay commented that any future outfits should be kept simple.

Under new business, the first topic of discussion was membership requirements. Bob questioned (1) non married and (2) van/trailer requirement. Matters were handled in reverse. Agreed to concept of tenters who were self supporting in mode of travel. Also, that once at sight (destination) all would pitch camp in the same area, conditions permitting. Proposed Amendment to Constitution, Section 1,D: "Own some type of motor vehicle for the mobility to travel and the ability to camp so they will be self-supporting (i.e., van, trailer, camper and/or tent.)"

Second point: There is nothing in the constitution or bylaws. Left up to the members to decide from each applicant.

Scheduled trips: Winter Jamboree 9-11 Dec. Area set up is without power, but there is a campground 15 minutes from the hall. Wagon master will check out.
